

➤ Athlete' s Checklist

✓ Has your athlete had a physical?

Physicals are good from one year of date of physical and Athlete' s Office.

✓ Have you & your athlete read and filled out the DCS Athlete' s Supplement Form?

✓ Have you signed a Parental Permission for the Release and Student' s photograph/image?

✓ Has your athlete met the Eligibility for OHSAA?

- Officially enrolled in an OHSAA member high school.
- Enrolled in at least five one-credit courses or the equivalent.
- Received passing grades in at least five one-credit courses or the equivalent, during the athlete' s last grading period.
- Live in the same school district as parents/legal guardian.
- Have not changed schools without a corresponding move by parent/legal guardian or by qualifying for one of the OHSAA transfer regulations.
- Have not been enrolled in high school for more than one year.
- Has not turned 19 before August 1, 2004.
- Have not received an award, equipment or prize valued at more than \$200.00.
- Competing under true name and have provided school with current home address.
- Have not competed in a mandatory open gym/facility during the season.
- Have not been coached or been provided instruction by a coach other than during sport season or for no more than 10 days during the season (June 1 and July 31 (applies to team sports only)).
- Has not competed on a non-school team during school year.
- Has not been recruited to attend this school.
- Have not used anabolic steroids or other performance enhancing drugs.
- Have had a physical examination within the past year at the school.
