Motion to approve May minutes: Cindy Decker, 2nd by Eric Spalsbury

Treasurer's Report:

Tim Hackett reported that our bank balance is \$3962.51. He is still compiling bills, receipts, etc. from the previous treasurer and will provide a detailed report asap. Tim reported that our Roush Sporting Goods balance is \$27,102.20. President Karen Harris would like to look into this balance since it is more than previously stated. Tim says that Keith Burns, the previous treasurer is going to ask the Athletic Boosters to pay the \$7000 still owed for uniforms. Tim also has received checks for the golf outing, mulch sale and receipts from Coach.

Coach's Report:

Coach would like us to purchase the high-end camera with "cowboy remote" and DVD player. A motion was made by Eric Spalsbury, 2nd by Mr. Akers that this AV equipment be purchased.

Coach also showed us magnets and a ball hat that could be used for fund raising. The cost for 250 would be \$550.00. If sold for \$10, we could make \$1900. Motion made by Al Hartley, 2nd by Tracy Whited to order 250 magnets. Ball caps are already on order for coaches and extras will be sold. The cost is \$14.00 each and we could sell them for \$20.00.

Coach showed us the equipment bag from Zides. These bags will be marked Delaware Football with uniform number. The cost will be \$33.00. He also showed us another bag from the Outer Layer that was not as sturdy. The cost on that bag was \$16.00. Motion made by Rick Bull, 2nd by Eric Spalsbury that we purchase the Zides bags. The bags would be for JV and Varsity. The freshman team would get the older bags. The bags would not belong to the players, but kept from year to year.

Coach also talked about a field stencil. It would be a horseshoe shape and could be used multiple times. The cost would run from \$1000 and up, depending on size. He will talk to Kevin Reed to see if he would pay for it.

Old Business:

Mulch Sale: Rene Weber to send post cards and e-mails to all customers and vendors.

Pacer Cards: Need to go to printer end of this week. Pres. Karen Harris read us new vendors that will appear on the cards. Discussion on how many cards each player should sell. After discussion, it was decided that ***JV-Varsity players will sell 15, Freshmen and Middle School will sell 10.*** Parent representatives from each grade will be there on the Blitz day to receive money. ***Each player will be responsible for selling his cards. No cards will be accepted as unsold: The player will keep selling until they are gone***
