

Touchdown Club Meeting

July 8, 2009

Motion to approve June minutes. Approved by Tracy White, 2nd by Cathy Heffernans.

Coach's Report:

Coach Freado joined us with the coach's report. He would like the cement walls by the ticket booth painted black on the inside of the field. He requested parent volunteers to do the painting. Bob Bender will be chairman: Eric, Dan, Al and Rick will help paint. Coach Freado also listed this year's purchases to date: Coach's gear, player's gear, hats (selling some to offset costs), video camera & DVD deck and stats software. Future purchases are office supplies. Coach Freado also mentioned that D's Steak House would like to do the team meal. Rene Weber will look into this. D's is going to host the Defensive Dinner. Coach Freado also told us that Coach "V" left to coach at DeSales. Coach Sanchez and Coach Lamb along with Taylor Wood will coach the freshmen. A new coach, Julian Street will coach the O & D for Varsity, and 7th and 8th grade will have 3 coaches level.

Treasurer's Report:

Tim Haclett passed out a detailed list of our expenses. We presently have \$9227.23 in our checking account. We have \$13,336.62 in liabilities. We are \$4109.39 short. The Golf Outing made approximately \$2851.00 in profit. Tim Haclett also reported that the Outer Layer had billed us for the T's. Pres. Karen Harris will talk with the manager regarding the billing. There was a printing problem with the t-shirts. Tim spoke about the non-interest free loan for the sports program and how that must be kept separate from our present account. Mona Spalsbury suggested that we get a totally separate bank account for this money. It was decided instead of a separate account, we will get a savings account and then transfer the money to the checking account. We will give a motion by Eric Spalsbury, voted unanimously by the representatives.

OLD BUSINESS:

Packer Cards: Karen Harris has received the check for parent volunteers for collecting the money on 8/7/09. Card Bull, Alan Healy, Bob Bender and Cathy Heffernans volunteered.

Equipment Bags from Zide will be coming for JV and Varsity only.

Sports Program Update: Still taking ads. Suggested that pictures be taken on the Biz day.

Parade: Divede rying gowell. Mona Spalsbury reported that it was a success and we had a good turnout.

Golf Outing:

Suggestions for next year:

- Payments must be made by Friday the day before the outing
- suggest that putting a place on the order for golf balls, putts and ski's game would save us from mass confusion the day of the outing.

- Once teams are set, a week before the outing, send out an email explaining the way each game is to work and the rules. This was not clear to teams this year.
- Important that we have people on the field selecting tickets.

Karen Harris asked Coach Fredo his suggestions as a player for the golf outing. He suggests doing away with the shirt and eliminating the door prizes. That instead of the door prizes, give away another drink to everyone a sleeve of balls with the Pacer Logo, or a golf towel. He also said that everyone really likes the photos of the teams. Discussion regarding Oak have's less than perfect hospitality. Should we look into another course for next year? Cathy He mans mentioned that we could send a save the date card for next year as we have a venue and date chosen.

NEW BUSINESS:

Homecoming Bonfire Committee: Karen Harris asked for volunteer to chair. Mona Spalsbury volunteered. Karen has all the information from last year.

Alumni Football Game: Cost is \$10 per alumni player. They will get a t-shirt. Karen is getting the t-shirts for \$2.50 each. We will have refs for the game. How much to pay refs? Have Kevin Reed's approval for Friday, August 7. Need volunteer to help. Al Hartley volunteered. Cheerleader should invite the alumni as well. Coach Lopez has approved introducing this year's varsity team at half time.

Yard Signs for New Players:

Cost of signs need to be \$15.00. This will not be paid by the TD Club.

Mona Spalsbury brought up the cost of overnight camp. Last year's parents were asked to donate items and they did not come through. It made it very difficult to be able to feed the 80+ boys. Mona spoke with Rene Weber and they asked if each player could contribute \$15.00 toward the cost of the camp. This would cover 2 breakfasts, 3 lunches and 3 dinners. Discussion showed, including TD club possibly paying for the camp, but due to our bank balance it would be difficult at this time.
